### **Installation Bulletin for 042-2028 and 042-2149**

#### **Vehicle Models:**

2001-2009	S60	All engines
1999-2005	S80	All engines
2001-2004	V70	All engines
2003-2007	XC70	All engines
2003-2010	XC90	All engines

Certain Volvo applications that use the Beck/Arnley cabin air filters 042-2028 and 042-2149 contain locations for both filters behind the glove box. This allows Volvo to use a single housing concept for all models, both for models with IAQS (Interior Air Quality System) equipment installed and models without. The filters are of different size and will only fit in their respective properly sized locations.

#### **With IAQS:**

Models with IAQS use a charcoal activated filter element (042-2149), which removes particulates as well as harmful pollutants from the cabin. This filter will use the location with the **larger** opening provided by the HVAC system.

#### **Without IAQS:**

Models without IAQS use a particulate/pollen filter element for which Beck/Arnley provides (042-2028). This filter will use the location with the **smaller** opening provided by the HVAC system.

#### **CAUTION:**

Please note that it is possible to install both filters at the same time. This is NOT recommended as it can cause an unwanted decrease in flow through the air vents and possibly other abnormal characteristics in the HVAC system. The system was designed for the flow provided by **ONLY** one filter element and will not function properly if both filters are installed at the same time.
